

DVD Information:

Our DVDs work on all TV DVD players. Some DVDs start up automatically.

- Others (like John Thornton's Electric Throttle Control) you will need to press "ENTER" on your remote control.
- If the DVD freezes at all, make sure your player is clean by blowing the dust out. If that fails, try rewinding or fast forwarding and the clicking play.

Some of our customers have issues with our DVDs on their computers, because in order to keep prices down we spend as little money as possible on professional editing and push them into market. Now, the DVDs are fine, but often you need to be able to troubleshoot with your own DVD software to get our DVDs to work.

- Make sure your DVD software and drivers are all installed and updated.
- If the DVD seems to freeze in the beginning, click enter or space bar.
- DVDs do not work in Windows Media Player. You need to use a DVD player program.
