

Have Your Tips & Tricks Seen in Motor Age! (con't from p. 1)

So, you get a 2006 Toyota Corolla and it has a P0171...

First you check TSBs and confirm that the PCM and Evap Purge Solenoid were replaced as per the recall, because they are known to set P0171 DTCs. Then you might smoke it cold and warm to look for vacuum leaks.



If you find that it checks out, you should test the A/F sensor and make sure the voltage moves positive when you cause a vacuum leak and goes negative when you add propane to make the fuel mixture rich. The A/F is a steady 3.3 V and appears to react logically. Your next step is to diagnose the MAF sensor because they go bad all the time on these vehicles. This can be done quickly by doing a volumetric efficiency test.

You can use an ATS EScan scan tool which has a built in volumetric efficiency test, or go to Google and use a volumetric efficiency calculator. An even quicker method is to go to WOT while looking at the Calculated Load PID in Generic OBD II on your scan tool. If it is lower than 90 percent inspect the MAF. Common on these Corollas that they are contaminated, so it is good to replace them. We have not had success cleaning these sensors on several vehicles.


Now, even if you did everything right do not be surprised if this vehicle comes back to you months later with the same problem! Why? Check your Freeze Frame. If the DTC sets when cold with a highly positive fuel trim, but otherwise LTFT appears to be good, this vehicle has an "impossible to find" intake manifold leak. (Con't on p. 7)







Tips & Tricks in Motor Age! (con't from p. 3)

You can confirm this two ways. The easy way is to smoke the intake with CO2 gas and use an emissions analyzer to find if you have elevated CO2 levels around the intake manifold as compared to atmospheric CO2. Otherwise, just pull the intake off.





What you will find is that the original gaskets flatten and the new replacement gasket is much more robust. This will solve your P0171, but without the right tools (scan tool, emissions analyzer, smoke machine) you will never be able to catch this fault.

2008 Hyundai Accent "Invisible Misfire" (Contributed by TST Associate Craig Truglia)

Many Hyundai Accents have a P0300 or other misfire DTCs, but the customer will report no obvious misfires. The vehicle in had a tune up with aftermarket spark plugs twice, never reporting a misfire. There is a TSB that recommends updating the PCM software.

How would we do this for a Hyundai? It is an easy process. A J2534 reprogramming device (the Drewtech Cardaq is recommended), 32-bit laptop with Windows XP, and <u>free</u> subscription to the Hyundaitechinfo.com is all that's needed.

- 1) DO NOT run any other programs other than the J2534 application.
- 2) DO NOT disturb or disconnect the DLC cable or interface cable.
- DO NOT turn the device OFF.
- 4) DO NOT turn the ignition key to the OFF position.
- 5) DO NOT start the engine.
- 6) DO NOT operate any electrical accessories. (climate control, lighting, audio, etc.)
- 7) Click [OK] button to continue (Click [Cancel] button to exit)



Here's how you do it. We have found that doing such a reflash is a straightforward and error-free process as long as you follow the precautions you see above.

Otherwise, simply check that the Calibration ID that is different than the old one and click "OK." Wait a few minutes, the screen will look static as if nothing is happening and the software will indicate when the reflash is done. That's it!

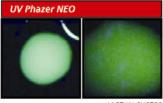



Which brings us to some changes TST is making in order to continue to provide quality and affordable training to you. We of the TST board always viewed TST not so much as a corporation, but a partnership between its members that allows us to bring in trainers in order to keep us up-to-date in the field of automotive repair.

However, maybe we were all too good at doing it. Thanks to our loyal membership we were able to do ten training events a year held live in four different state chapters. That's 37 classes a year with thirteen different instructors. That's a lot of training!

Many members have reported that they have already taken certain classes or topics like it, because TST holds so many training events. This has led to picking and choosing of classes which is making it difficult to provide ten different topics a year in so many locations. So, we will be doing more than holding Big Events nationwide. We plan on bringing many of you online where we can provide training at an affordable price. Monthly we provide free training webcasts on **TSTseminars.org**. 



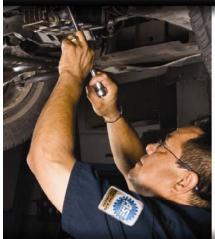
